## The ideal candidate will have:

- A post-secondary degree in biological sciences and/or education.
- Previous teaching or interpretation experience.
- Experience developing educational programs.
- Knowledge of West Coast ecosystems, local history, and local culture.
- Experience collaborating with Indigenous communities
- Experience working outdoors for extended periods of time.
- Experience in risk management and implementing safety protocols.
- Confident working independently, who can manage their time effectively, and collaborate with the rest of team.
