The RES is looking for a part-time field assistant to help with marine debris surveys in Barkley and Clayoquot Sound.

- conducting and assisting with standardized debris surveys along beaches and shorelines throughout

- after training and familiarization, approximately half of the work will be self-directed at your own pace, on your own schedule
- the remainder will consist of boat-based surveys working with a team leader

An ideal candidate will have/be:

- general background in science (this is an asset but not a requirement)
- familiar with our area of operations in Barkley and Clayoquot Sounds
- familiarity working in small boats on the water (an asset, not a requirement)
- attention to detail and a willingness to work in inclement weather a must
- due to the nature and schedule of the work, priority will be given to applicants who reside in the region
