Small Town, Big Picture

Two towns, two courses. Each delivers the “big picture” of living in a small town. Learn about local history and basic ecology, cross-cultural understanding, businesses and activities, festivals, host etiquette, and important civic information. This is a great way to get up-to-date local information about living and working in Tofino or Ucluelet. Take one or take both. These courses are a suggested prerequisite for other courses.

Marine Ecology

Learn about the rich marine environment that plays an integral role in life on this coast. This course will cover the intertidal and pelagic ecosystems including seaweeds, invertebrates and marine mammals (and more!) as well as local oceanographic conditions.

Coastal Rainforest Ecology

Who knew old-growth forests are so dynamic? Far from being a static ecosystem our coastal temperate rainforest is always changing! From the forest floor to the top of the canopy, this course will explore the many interactions that make up the fabric of this iconic habitat.
